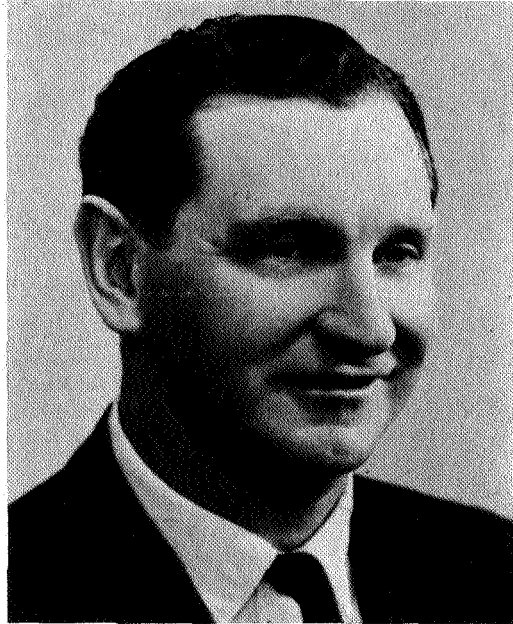


HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

The wide-ranging activities of Bob Norton in Dentistry have been recognized by other Societies. He is an Honorary Life Member of both the Australian Dental Association and the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Dental Association. He is also an Honorary Member of the American Dental Association and the Korean Dental Association.

His long service to the Australian Society of Orthodontists includes election to the following offices – President (1959–1961), Councillor (1950–1969), Honorary Secretary (1950–1956), President N.S.W. Branch (1958), Honorary Secretary/Treasurer of the A.S.O. Foundation for Research and Education (1964–).

In addition he has played a most active role as office bearer in both the State and Federal Branches of the Australian Dental Association – Federal Councillor (1957–), Federal Honorary Secretary (1960–1961), Federal Honorary Treasurer (1964–1966), President N.S.W. Branch (1956–1958), Chairman Postgraduate Education Committee (1964–1968), Member of Executive N.S.W. Branch (1949–1968), Federal Vice-President (1966–1968), Federal President (1968–1970), Chairman Constitution Committee (1970), Vice-President 16th Australian Dental Congress, Vice-President 20th Australian Dental Congress, Chairman, Dental Research and Education Trust (1969–), Representative of the Australian Dental Association as follows: A.P.D.F. (1967, 1970), F.D.I. (1969, 1970), N.Z.D.A. (1968).

Bob has in addition been a member of the Dental Board of New South Wales (1967–), Postgraduate Committee in Dental Science, University of Sydney (1968–), Vice-President, Dental Health Education and Research Foundation, University of Sydney (1961–1963). He is also an Affiliated Member of the American Association of Orthodontists and a Corresponding Member of the British Society of Orthodontists and the European Orthodontic Society.

Bob has also been a part-time Lecturer in Orthodontics at the University of Sydney since 1949 and is Senior Orthodontist at the Sydney Legacy Dental Clinic. Bob is in private orthodontic practice in Sydney, having commenced in 1945 with Dr. A. Thornton Taylor.

At the General Meeting of the Society held in Sydney in August, 1974, Bob Norton was elected an Honorary Life Member of the Society.
