A Nor'easter (informally known as a Nor'easter) is a cyclonic storm characteristic of the eastern seaboard of North America. Especially associated with fall and winter weather in New England and the mid-Atlantic, Nor'easters deliver snow, rain, and strong winds. Winslow Homer, active in the late 19th and very early 20th centuries, was one of the most prominent American painters of any time period. Notable themes of his work include sailors, fisherman, and the ocean. He completed *Nor'easter*, featured on this issue's cover of *Immunohematology*, in 1895. A case report in this issue, authored by Chousal et al., addresses hemolysis due to anti-IH, a cold agglutinin.
