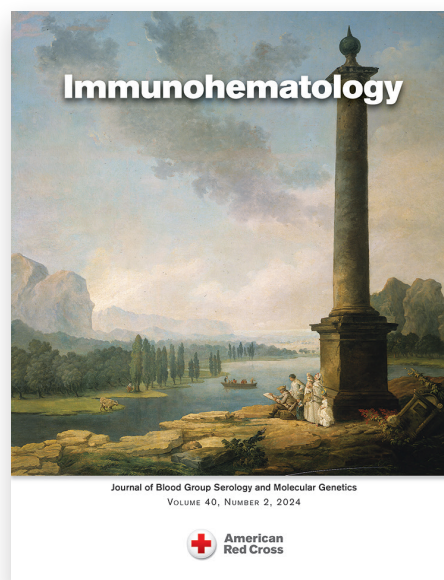
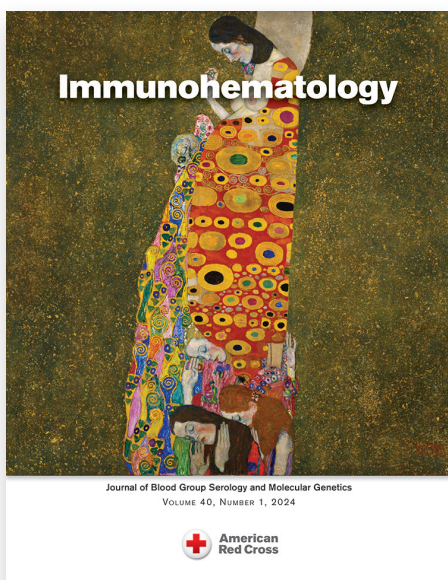


To contributors to the 2024 issues

Improvements to ScholarOne, such as peer reviewers selecting provided Key Words to identify their field of expertise/interest for reviewing, are in progress. Our ongoing collaboration with Sciendo/DeGruyter for management of our subscriptions and online access at <https://sciendo.com/journal/IMMUNOHEMATOLOGY> has seen changes to our home page and improvements for our readers. Douglas Roberts joined our *Immunohematology* team in early 2024 as our Production Assistant and has been paramount in managing subscription orders and acting as the liaison for ScholarOne changes. *Immunohematology*, again, published four issues with online access and printed copies per subscription orders. And again, this continuation of our publishing process would not have been possible without the continued efforts of our *Immunohematology* team!
