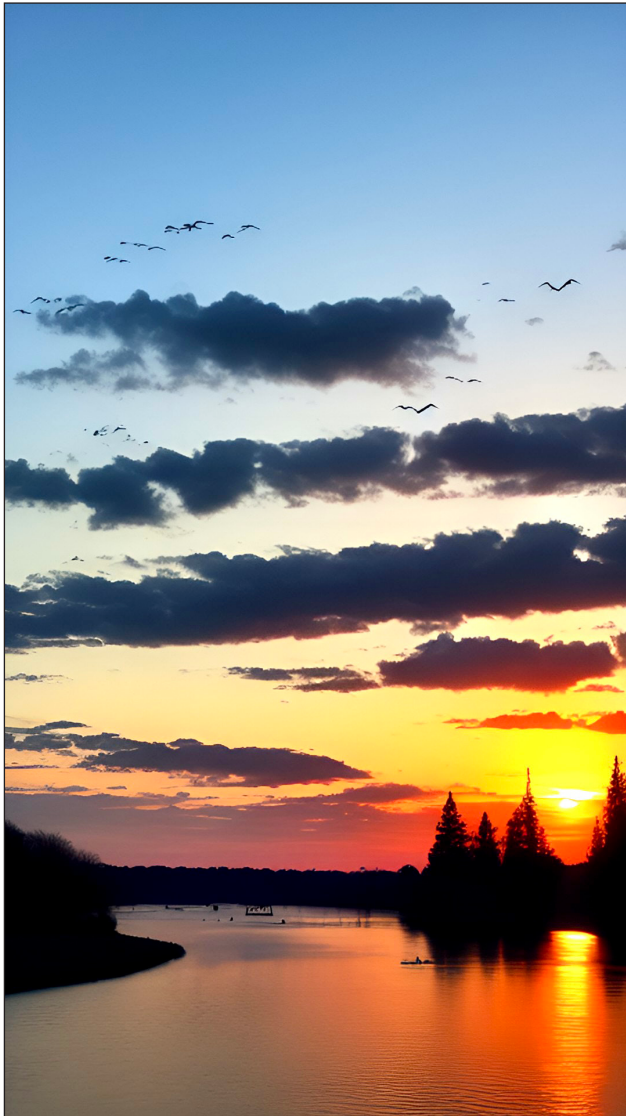


Image 1 Geese Flying High.



Image 2 Murmuration of Starlings.

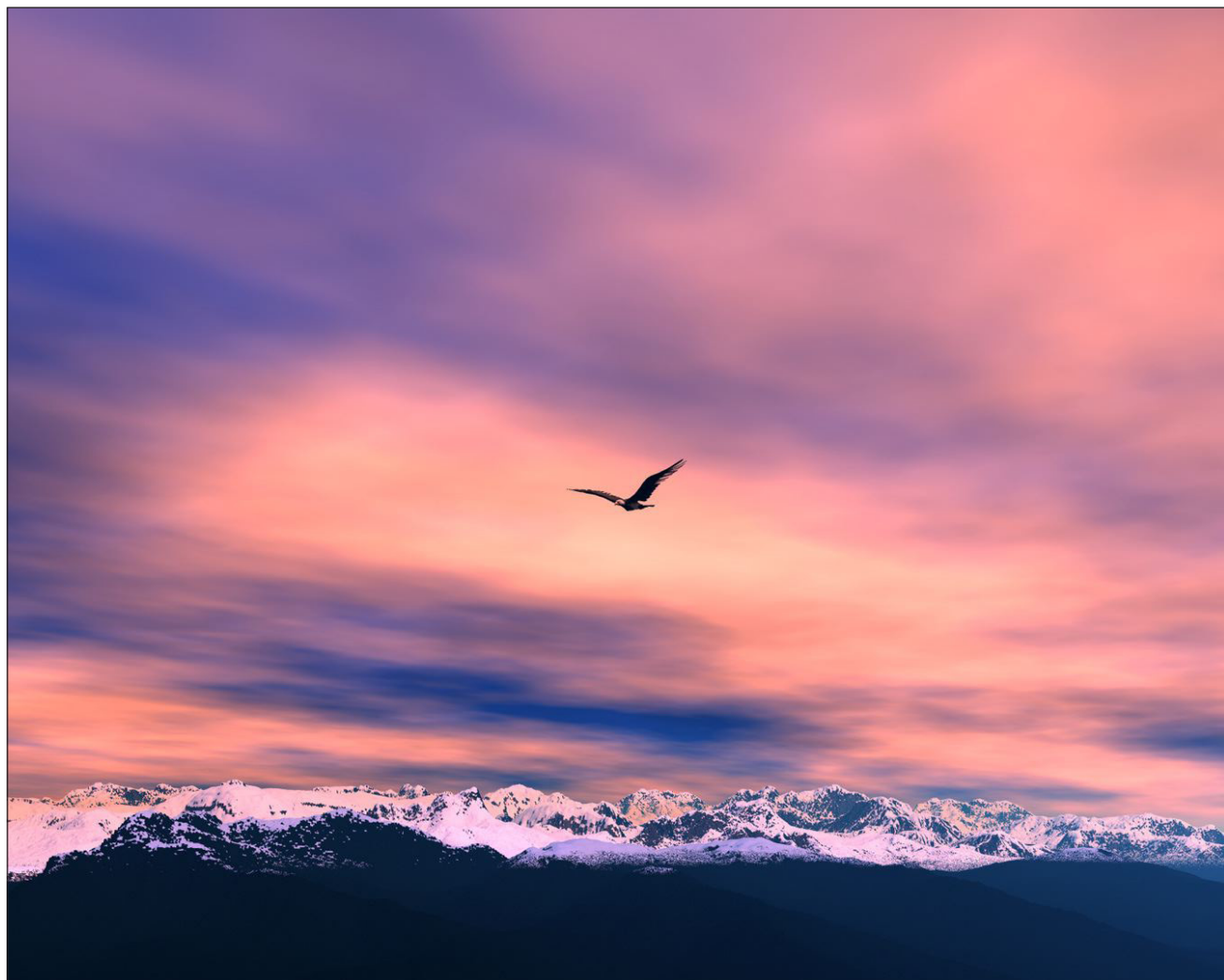


Image 3 Watching Over His Country.
