The authors wish to provide the following clarifications and corrections to the published article.

1. Removal of incorrect reference (Syssner, 2020)

A reference to Syssner (2020) was included in error and does not correspond to an existing publication. The reference resulted from an unintended conflation of sources. The associated statement is of a general nature and does not rely on a specific source.

Locations of correction:
