Scientific Program

The theme of the 6th International CACGP Symposium will be *Global Tropospheric Chemistry*, in keeping with the developing Global Tropospheric Chemistry Program. Primary emphasis will be on global distributions and trends of trace gases and aerosols which play important rôles in tropospheric chemical cycles. Papers concerned with fluxes to the troposphere from the biosphere, chemical transformations in the global troposphere, removal processes and rates in remote regions, and modeling the global tropospheric chemical system are also appropriate. Papers on all chemical cycles are solicited, but there will be at least one special session on organic acids and related compounds in the troposphere.

Abstracts and Proceedings

The tentative deadline for submission of abstracts is 1 April 1987. Abstracts (in English or French) up to 300 words, single spaced, must include title, authors, affiliations and addresses. Two copies of each abstract are to be sent to:
