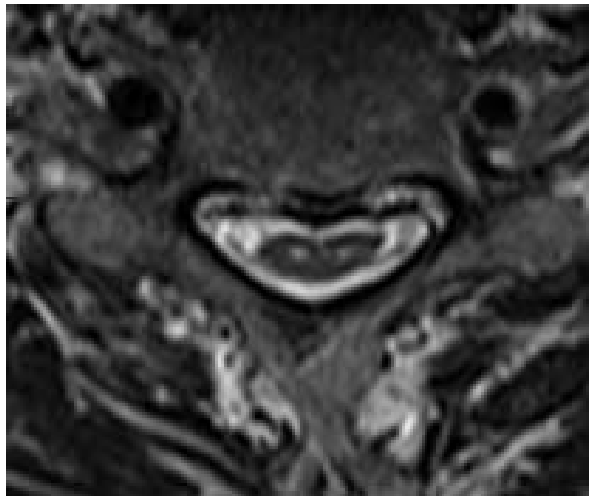

2.1 What is the diagnosis?



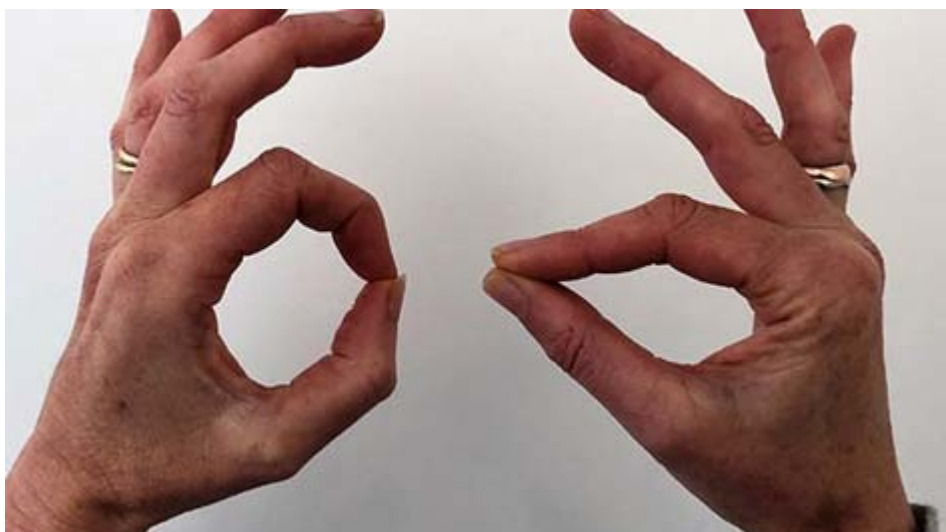

3.1 What is the diagnosis?

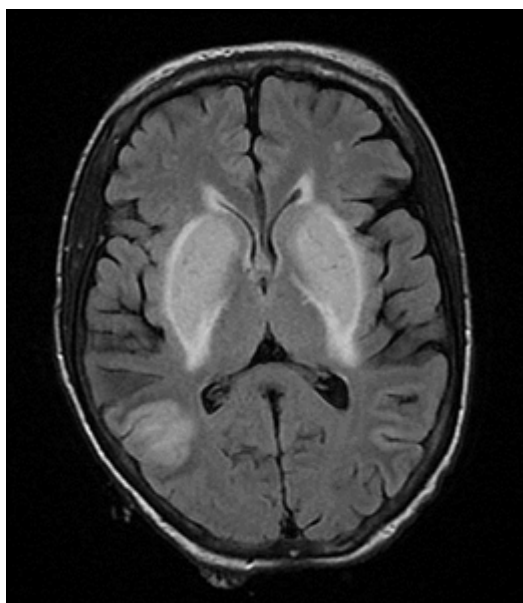


Question 4
