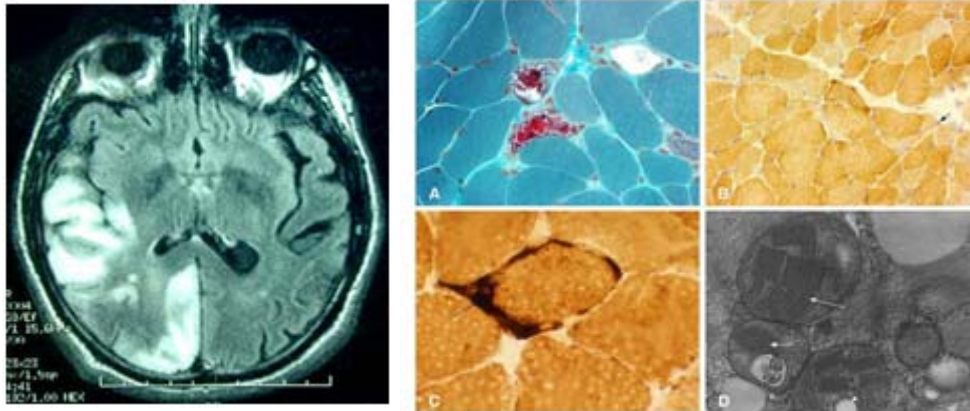

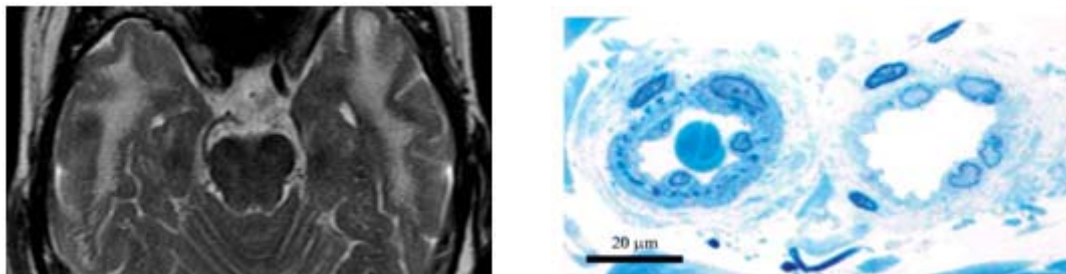
Stroke

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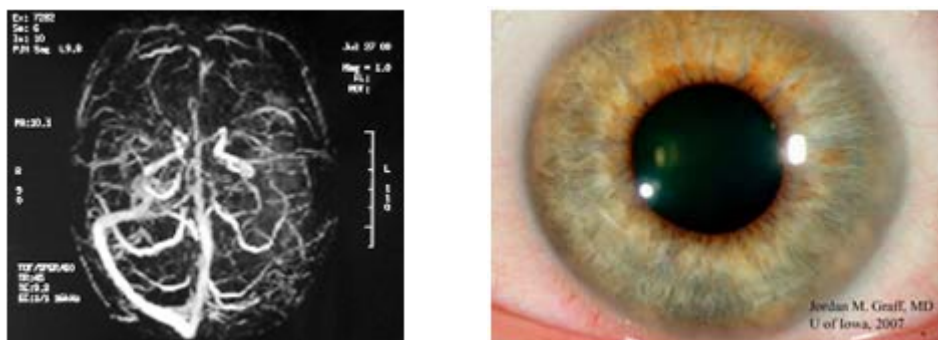
1. This 25-year-old patient presented with a stroke. MRI brain and muscle biopsies are shown. What is the diagnosis?



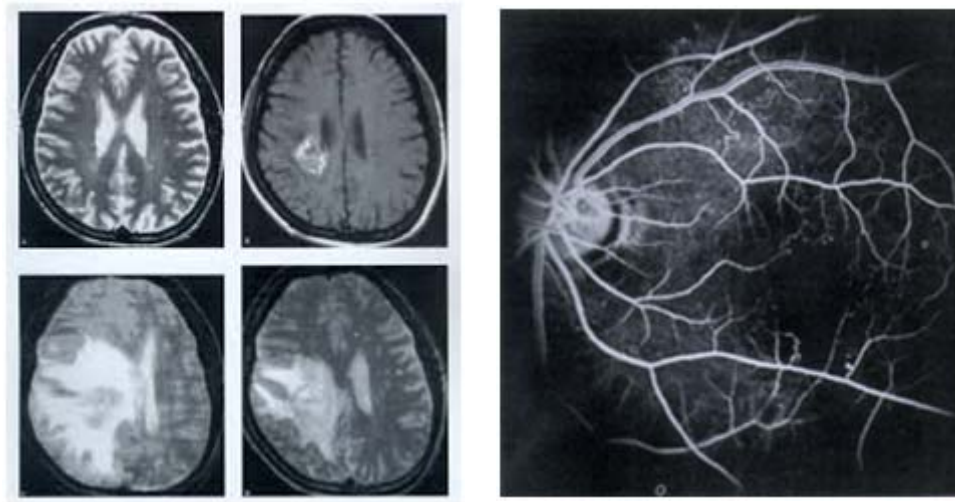

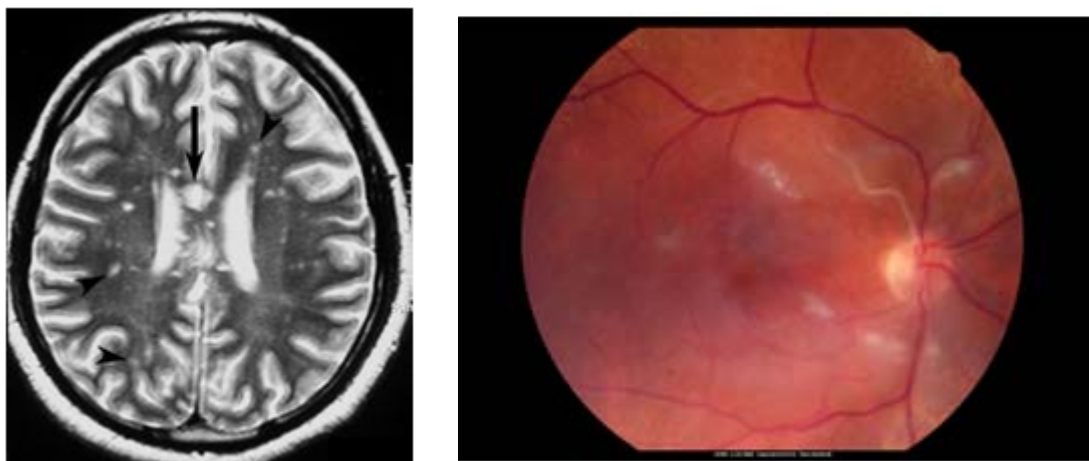
