1. Aims and scope of the Journal

The *Balkan Journal of Medical Genetics (BJMG)*, established in 1998, covers all areas of human genetics. Topics include cytogenetics, molecular genetics, clinical genetics, immunogenetics, oncogenetics, pharmacogenetics, population genetics, genetic screening and diagnosis of monogenic and polygenic diseases, prenatal and preimplantation genetic diagnosis, genomic and other omics technologies, genetic counselling, and advancements in the treatment and prevention of genetic disorders.

The journal is supported by an international editorial board and welcomes the submission of manuscripts that meet the criteria of scientific significance and excellence. BJMG publishes original research articles, case studies, reviews, surveys, opinions, commentaries, and essays.

2. Identification Statement

The *Balkan Journal of Medical Genetics* is published online twice a year by the Macedonian Academy of Sciences and Arts, Skopje, Republic of North Macedonia. The journal is accessible at the following websites: www.bjmg.edu.mk, www.sciendo.com and www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc.

3. Publication fees

A publication fee of **500 euros** per accepted paper applies. No fees are charged for manuscript submission.

Authors must submit a signed **License to Publish** and **Publication Cost Approval** form (available at www.bjmg.edu.mk and www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc.) at the time of submission. These documents confirm the authors' agreement to cover the publication costs upon acceptance.

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Manuscripts must be written in **English** and submitted via email as a **Microsoft Word attachment** to the Editorial Office:

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Each submission must include:

- A cover letter confirming the originality of the manuscript and its exclusive submission to BJMG
- A signed **License to Publish** and **Publication Cost Approval**
- Any necessary **patient consent statements** for identifiable information
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Upon acceptance, all manuscripts and accompanying materials become the property of the publisher.

5. Manuscript Review

All manuscripts undergo **editorial evaluation** and are subject to **peer review** by at least two expert reviewers. Authors may suggest potential reviewers with full contact details. All submissions are treated as **confidential** and are not shared outside the editorial and review process without authorization.

6. Preparation of manuscript

- All new manuscripts must be accompanied by a cover letter from the corresponding author stating that the manuscript represents original, unpublished material not under editorial consideration elsewhere, and that ethical guidelines were followed in the conduct of the research.
- Manuscripts must follow the **Vancouver style**, be **double-spaced**, and include **2.5 cm margins** on all sides. Follow the **ICMJE Recommendations** for formatting (see [ICMJE.org](http://www.icmje.org)).
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- An **abstract** of no more than 250 words should start on page 2. A list of **3-6 key words** in alphabetic order.
- The **main text** should be structured as: *Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgments, Declaration of Interest, References, Figure Legends, Tables*.

- **Declaration of Interest.** The authors declare no conflicts of interest. The authors alone are responsible for the content and writing of this article.
- Cite each reference, figure and table in strict **numerical order**: [1-5]; (Table 1); (Figure 1).
- References (not exceeding 30-40 in number) should be numbered in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text. Please cite all authors if there are only six; cite the first six authors followed by et al. if there are more than six authors listed. Follow **AMA Manual of Style (9th ed.)**. Journal names should be abbreviated according to **Index Medicus**

- Tables should be placed **at the end of the manuscript**, each on a new page with a title and footnotes. Use **tabs** (not spaces) to align columns. Figures should be submitted as **separate files** and numbered consecutively.
