Author Guidelines

Studies in Business and Economics (SBE) is an open-access journal that publishes both theoretical and empirical research papers in the fields of Economics and Business.

The main objectives of Studies in Business and Economics are to:

- increase the international visibility and dissemination of authors and their research;
- promote international knowledge transfer in scientific domains such as Economics, Business, Management, Marketing, International Business, Accounting, Banking and Finance, Business Ethics, and Corporate Social Responsibility.

The journal was launched in 2006, initially with one issue per year. Since 2010, it has been published three times per year.

Issues are released in April/May, August/September, and December/January.

Review Process

All manuscripts undergo an initial desk check. Submissions that do not comply with the author guidelines or manuscript template will be desk-rejected.

Manuscripts that pass the desk check are evaluated by the editors to determine their suitability for peer review. Eligible manuscripts are then double-blind peer reviewed. Authors will receive reviewers' feedback within up to 25 weeks. The possible outcomes are:

- Accept
- Minor revision
- Major revision
- Reject

Manuscript specifications

Submissions must meet the following requirements:

- The manuscript must be original, not previously published, and not under review elsewhere.
- Length: **6,000–8,000 words**.
- The first page must include:
 - Author name(s) and affiliation(s) (maximum **5 authors**).
 - An abstract of up to **200 words**.
 - **3–5 keywords**.
- Formatting:
 - Font: **Arial, 10 pt** (title: **14 pt**).
 - Line spacing: **1.2**.
- Page setup:
 - Paper size: **Envelope B5**.
 - Margins: **Top 1.5 cm, Bottom 1.5 cm, Left 2.0 cm, Right 2.0 cm**.
- Submission: Manuscripts must be submitted electronically in **MS Word format** via [ScholarOne Manuscripts](#).
- Notes & References: Footnotes are not allowed. In-text citations must follow the format (*Author, Year*). References should be listed at the end of the paper in **APA Style**.

Open Access

SBE is an open-access journal, providing free, immediate, and unrestricted online access to all published content worldwide.

Authors must sign the Open Access License/License to Publish.

Fees

SBE does not charge article processing fees or submission fees.

Rejection-rate: ~85%.
