

Editorial Policy

Social Change Review (SCR) is an international peer-reviewed journal edited by the Department of Social Work, Journalism, Public Relations, and Sociology of the Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu. It aims to provide a forum for research and scientific debates on a wide range of topics related to social change and transformation within current societies. The journal explores social, cultural, and political change from various perspectives within the larger field of social sciences. Both empirical-based (quantitative or qualitative approaches) and theoretical contributions are most welcome.

Social Change Review is open to a large variety of topics related to social change and may include: research articles, research essays, research notes, and book reviews. We welcome manuscripts of all authors wishing to publish in Social Change Review. The accepted manuscripts are published online first, in a continuous process, being then included in an annual volume, at the end of each calendar year.

Special issues have a guest editor and aim to publish contributions interrelated under a common heading. They normally are opened to the same four types of contributions. However the guest editor is free to decide his preference for a specific type of contribution (only research articles, for example). The topics of the special issues are announced in advance both on SCR website and within the final pages of previous printed issues.

Submitted articles are subject to double-blind peer reviewing.
